New Business

An amendment to the RVers of Idaho Constitution was distributed to all Chapters for a vote: add "Article IX Each membership (rig) whose dues for the current year are paid will have one vote in their primary chapter on business of RVers of Idaho." Discussion. Vote is 8 in favor; 4 opposed. Not the 3/4s required. Discussion pointed out that with this vote no one had authority over the \$45,000 in the Treasury. Craig called for a recount. Motion passed 9 in favor; 3 opposed. Amendment is adopted.

The proposed operational guide side-by-side explanation (as requested by the membership) was distributed. Because the proposed guideline is written in a different order than the current guideline, the group decided to discuss it at meeting of chapter presidents this Friday.
